



## Juvenile Redeploy Illinois FY25 ICOY's Capacity Building Assessment Tool for Organizations (CBAT-O) & Trauma-Informed Care Training Expectations

The Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) has contracted with the Illinois Collaboration on Youth (ICOY) to assess, train and work with IDHS youth services program providers to build trauma capacity. IDHS and ICOY recognize that Juvenile Redeploy Illinois program sites and contracted service providers face barriers that prevent them from completing the Capacity Building Assessment Tool for Organizations (CBAT-O). To address these needs, ICOY is communicating the process and expectations for Juvenile Redeploy Illinois programs to complete the CBAT-O and participate in trauma-informed care trainings during FY25 to ensure that these programs advance in trauma-informed practices.

### ICOY CBAT-O Expectations

- All JRI program sites are expected to complete ICOY's annual CBAT-O, which launches on October 1, 2024. For those sites who subcontract with individuals, or who do not fit the "organizational model" (such as single therapists, county boards, or probation departments, etc.), ICOY will directly inform each JRI program site of their FY25 participation expectations for the CBAT-O. Overall, ICOY encourages all sites to participate to the best of their abilities.
  - Agencies subcontracted by JRI are expected to participate in the CBAT-O.
    - Redeploy sites or subcontractors that cannot participate in the CBAT-O will be required to join our training curriculum and a Learning Community in Spring 2025. More information about this will be announced in the coming months.

### ICOY Training Expectations

- All JRI sites and subcontractors are expected to attend ICOY's Trauma-Informed Care (TIC) trainings. The training schedule includes 13 distinct TIC training courses, for more information, [please click here](#).
- In January 2025, ICOY will identify which JRI program sites and/or subcontractors:
  1. Did not participate in FY25 CBAT-O
  2. Have not attended any TIC trainings.
  3. JRI Sites will then be reminded of expectations both for trainings and the Virtual Learning Community and will have until March 2025 to complete expectations.

ICOY will communicate FY25 TIC participation for all JRI programs and sites to IDHS throughout FY (Fiscal Year) 2025. Additionally, ICOY will meet with JRI programs and/or sites that do not
