The Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention Act, 1974 (JJDPA) created the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP). The OJJDP supports delinquency prevention programs with grants managed by the State Advisory Group (SAG).
